## **PURPOSE AND PERSEVERANCE**

## Paul's Encouragement To Timothy

- Paul pointed to his life as a pattern (2 Timothy 3:10 NKJV)
  - 1. Purpose: something for which someone strives
  - 2. Perseverance: a continuous, steady belief or effort
- Paul's pattern is still viable today
  - 1. Purpose is not limited to a chosen few
  - 2. Perseverance is necessary because life is not all downhill
  - 3. The good news: as a believer, you have access to both qualities

## A PICTURE OF PURPOSE AND PERSEVERANCE

- Rizpah had a purpose (2 Samuel 21:8-10 CSB)
  - 1. Wanted to see her boys given a proper burial
  - 2. The boys were all she had left
- Rizpah had perseverance a steady effort for five months
  - 1. She had to push past the difficulty
  - 2. She had to push past discouragement
  - 3. Her actions convicted a king (2 Samuel 21:11-14 CSB)

## LIVING WITH PURPOSE AND PERSEVERANCE

- Clarify a bigger purpose for your life
  - 1. People are looking for purpose
  - 2. The purpose that impacts two realms (Colossians 1:9-10 CSB)
- To persevere push past discomfort and difficulty
  - 1. Things of true value are neither cheap nor easy
  - 2. Living for the Lord is neither easy nor cheap (1 Corinthians 16:13-14)
  - 3. He will enrich your life not eliminate every problem
- To persevere hold onto hope
  - 1. Hope is the expectation of good
  - 2. Hope helps us keep a steady effort and belief (1 Thessalonians 1:2-3 NKJV)
  - 3. Our hope is in the person of Jesus Christ
