- · Connections make a difference
 - 1. Cell phone calls dislike half sentences and missed words
 - 2. Loved ones the idea of drifting apart is not good
 - 3. Working with teams the more serious the objective, the stronger the connection need
- Our most valuable connection is with the Lord
 - 1. Has eternal consequences and benefits in both worlds
 - 2. Good to come closer (Psalms 73:28 NKJ)
 - 3. Trust is a part of any good relational connection

A WOMAN WHO MADE A STRONG CONNECTION WITH JESUS (Mark 5:24-34 CSB)

- · Nothing about her is standout or amazing
 - 1. We don't know her name/age/appearance/status
- She initiated the connection to Jesus
 - 1. Based only on what she had heard about Him
 - 2. Her faith was revealed in her words/actions
- · She displayed some determination/grit
 - 1. Overcame the physical problem of weakened condition and crowds
 - 2. Overcame the tradition of that culture regarding women with bleeding problems
 - 3. Overcame the fear of punishment (Jesus was with a synagogue ruler)
- Jesus' response is worth noting
 - 1. He did not correct her He blessed her, and she walked away healed

- · Your faith makes all the difference
 - 1. What do you believe about Jesus? (Galatians 2:20 CSB)
 - 2. What do you believe about yourself?
 - 3. Faith is revealed in words and actions

 - 1. The message is we have some confidence and endurance
 - 2. Everyone faces resistance to making a stronger connection
