## **OUR CURRENT ENVIRONMENT AND CULTURE**

- Does not support living for God
  - 1. An undercurrent that flows away from God
  - 2. A media environment that ranges from dismissive to disdainful
  - 3. Man and man's knowledge is exalted over God
- We have to stay intentionally determined to stay connected to God (Romans 12:1-2 CSB)
  - 1. We have to do something with our bodies a living sacrifice
  - 2. We have to renew our mindset, our perspective
  - 3. A transformed life is the goal not a conformed life

## FOUR MEN WHO THRIVED IN AN ADVERSARIAL ENVIRONMENT

- Given the golden ticket (Daniel 1:3-7 CSB)
  - 1. Taken from an insignificant nation to the most advanced nation and culture
  - 2. Given an opportunity to live on a much higher level than the other captives
- Were forced into a culture that had no regard for their God
  - 1. The school's purpose was to indoctrinate them into Chaldean culture
  - Their names were changed to take God out
  - 3. Forced to learn a new language
  - 4. Forced to change their food to foods that were forbidden by God
- The four determined (purposed in heart) not to be defiled
  - 1. Defile = to pollute, stain, make impure
  - 2. Asked for a test godly wisdom (Daniel 1:8-9, 14-20 CSB)
  - 3. God caused them to stand out better looking and smarter than their peers

## TO STAY CONNECTED, STAY ON GUARD

- Guard against things that defile you (James 1:27 CSB)
  - 1. The Old Testament was involved with outward things don't touch, don't eat
  - 2. Things that defile, pollute, stain today are inside things
  - 3. Words, arguments, and worthless information (2 Timothy 2:14-17 NLT)
- Guard against identity theft
  - 1. How we identify is a connector or separator
  - Our identity in Christ is a connector to Him (Colossians 2:6-7 NLT)
  - 3. We don't allow the flow/thinking of this age to define us
  - 4. We speak a different language
