LIFE SKILL OF TRUSTING IN THE LORD (Psalm 37:3 NKJV)

- A direct counter to fretting
 - 1. Will involve trusting in God's Word
 - 2. Trust and do good good works are hard to argue with
 - 3. Dwell in the land
- · Cultivate / feed on faithfulness
 - 1. Faithfulness is firmness, steadfastness
 - 2. Cultivate faithfulness in the little things (Luke 19:17 NKJV)
 - 3. Feed securely on His faithfulness (1 Corinthians 1:9 NKJV) (Psalm 119:138 NKJV)

DELIGHTING IN THE LORD (Psalm 37:4 NKJV)

- · How do you delight in the Lord?
 - 1. Taking pleasure in the Lord
 - 2. Revealed by actions (Job 22:21-25 NKJV) (1 Timothy 6:10 NKJV)
 - 3. Then your delight is in the Lord (Job 22:26-27 NKJV)
- Delighting in the Lord is honoring the Lord with your life (Isaiah 58:13-14 NKJV)
 - 1. We don't treat the Sabbath today as different
 - 2. The principle of honoring God is still the same (Galatians 5:22-24 NKJV) (Ephesians 4:29 NKJV)
 - 3. Then after putting these principles into practice (Matthew 6:33 NKJV)

COMMITTING YOUR WAY TO THE LORD (Psalm 37:5 NKJV)

- Trusting God with your life
 - 1. Very similar to the prayer of consecration that Jesus prayed (Luke 22:41-42 NKJV)
