- Hagar was in a tough situation (Genesis 16:5-11, 13-14 NLT)
 - 1. Her attitude got her in trouble
 - 2. Sara was harsh to her
 - 3. Abraham would not protect
- · God met her in the wilderness
 - 1. She ran away all alone, pregnant, and no hope for the future
 - 2. The angel of God told her to go back
- Hagar returned to a tough situation with a different mindset
 - 1. She had a promise for her future
 - 2. She called God by a different name
 - 3. Armed with new value she was able to handle Sara

- Look through a different lens (Romans 12:2 NLT)
 - 1. Called renewing the mind changing how you see things / mindset
 - 2. What does God say about you? (Ephesians 2:10 NLT)
 - 3. What are His promises to you?
- Refer to God in a different way
 - 1. Thanksgiving is one of the best ways to bring this into your life
 - 2. He is the God who... (Romans 8:31 NLT) (Romans 8:39 NLT)
 - 3. Armed with new value, you are better equipped to handle the tougher places of life
