GOD'S SUPERNATURAL FUEL

- · We have to eat
 - 1. Jesus knew the importance of God's Word (Luke 4:4 NKJV)
- The Manna example Exodus 16:14-15, 21 NKJV)
 - 1. God gave them supernatural bread from heaven
 - 2. They had to go and gather it every day
 - 3. God has provided supernatural food for us (John 6:63 NKJV)
 - 4. Very similar to natural eating (Psalms 119:28 NKJV)

A POWERFUL PROCESS TOOL

- God told Joshua how to be successful (Joshua 1:8 NKJV)
 - 1. Prosper: to succeed, cause to turn out successfully
 - 2. Good success: to be prudent, give insight, marked by sound judgment, to act wisely
- Not limited to Joshua (Psalms 1:2-3 NKJV)
 - 1. Prosper the same word as in Joshua
 - 2. Paul's instructions to Timothy (1 Timothy 4:15 NKJV)
- Meditation the common factor in progress and success
 - 1. Meditation: to mutter, to speak, to ponder
 - 2. Meditation involves our thinking
 - 3. Meditation involves our speaking (Psalms 119:9 & 11 NKJV)
- Meditation by speaking God's Word is a powerful tool
 - 1. Gives understanding (Psalms 49:3 NKJV)
 - 2. Puts life into our words (Proverbs 18:21 NKJV)
 - 3. Helps us control our thoughts (Proverbs 4:20-23 CSB)
