A DIFFERENT VISION

- What you see impacts your life (Luke 11:34-35 NKJV)
 - 1. Teams see themselves either winning or losing.
 - 2. Salespeople are constantly having to see themselves doing well
 - 3. People make relationship choices based on how they see themselves
- You can change what you see (Psalms 119:130 NKJV)
 - 1. A key way God's Word causes change
 - 2. Three areas where you need light

A Man With A Distorted Perspective

- There was a strong bond between David and Jonathan (1 Samuel 20:14-17 NKJV)
 - 1. The covenant was a commitment that extended to their respective families
- David is looking for someone to show kindness to (2 Samuel 9:1-7 NKJV)
 - 1. David wanted to do good and initiated contact with Mephibosheth
 - 2. Mephibosheth had been given wrong information about David
 - 3. Caused Mephibosheth to be afraid of David
- David did good to Mephibosheth
 - 1. Blessed him by restoring lands that belonged to his grandfather
 - 2. Blessed him by elevating his position in the kingdom sit at David's table
 - 3. Blessed not because of anything Mephibosheth had done because of Jonathan

SEEING ON A DIFFERENT LEVEL

- Because of Jesus, you are no longer separated from God (Romans 5:1-2 NKJV)
 - 1. Peace with God because of Jesus
 - 2. Access to God's grace
- Because of Jesus, you can have a different perspective of God
 - 1. God is not looking to hurt you
 - 2. God is not the source of your pain and hurt
 - 3. God is for you (Romans 8:31-32 NKJV)
- To see on a different level
 - 1. Know what the covenant says
 - 2. Start to praise and thank God on the basis of what you believe (*Psalms 18:1-3 NKJV*)
